

Prayer: Talking with God



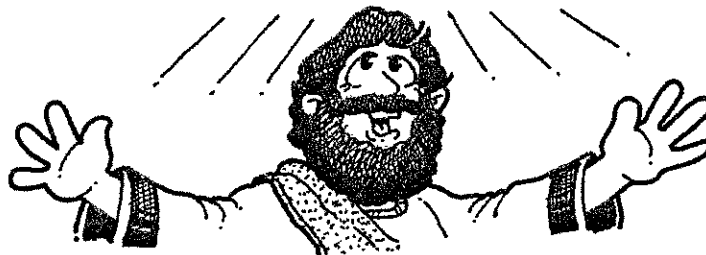
How do we talk with God?
